1st 4 levels will be 30 minutes; thereafter blind levels will be raised every 20 minutes through level 13; levels 14 and 15 will consist of 9 hands each (18 hands total). If there is more than one table at the start of level 14, all tables will play hand-for-hand and balance according to TDA Rule: Balancing Tables and Halting Play. Ante is paid before the big blind. Registration will close at the start of the 5th level (Approx. 1:45pm). This event will be 9 handed when manageable. Redraw at 27 and 9. **Tournament ends at the completion of level 15, all remaining player's chip stacks will be counted and each player will receive payout in relation to their chip equity based on the remaining prize pool after subtracting the minimum payout at the time of the end of the 15th level. Standard prize pool payouts will be calculated based on paying top 10% of entries or final 9 players, whichever is more. The Action Clock by Protection Poker will be used after registration closes and the field is down to 27 players. Players will have 30 seconds to act on their hand. Players will receive 2 time extensions worth 30 seconds each. Upon reaching the final table (9 or less players), each remaining player will receive 2 additional time extension chips. Once heads up, each player will receive 2 additional time extensions. *\$100 buy-in + \$15 entry fee + \$10 service charge.
