All levels will be 30 minutes until tournament is concluded. Ante is paid before the big blind. Registration will close at the start of the 10th level (Approx. 7pm). Top 15% of entries will make the money. Players may re-enter twice during the registration period. This event will be 7-handed; redraw for seats at 9. Tournament ends at last player with chips or if players agree to divide the remaining prize pool at the final table. Day 1 will play down to 6 or until midnight. Day 2 will start on Tuesday 1/7 at 1pm. **Players in line to register before 2pm may qualify for no entry fee; players that register after 2pm will pay \$1,000 entry fee (\$700 Entry fee + \$300 Service charge); players that re-enter will pay \$500 entry fee (\$350 Entry fee + \$150 Service Charge). Entry fee not added to prize pool. 100% of buy-in goes toward the prize pool. Players earn points toward 2020 Poker Central High Roller Player of The Year; visit www.pokercentral.com for details. The Action Clock by Protection Poker will be used throughout the entire tournament when manageable. Players will have 30 seconds to act on their hand. Players will receive 5 time extensions worth 30 seconds each. Players' time extensions will carry over to the final table where each player will receive 5 additional time extension buttons. In the case that time expires for a player with remaining time extension chips, the player's Action Clock will automatically extend an additional 30 seconds. Collection of time extension buttons will take place at the end of the player's action. If a player's Action Clock expires and the player does not have any time extension chips remaining, he or she will be (a) forced to check if there is no bet pending or (b) fold if facing a bet or raise. In order to register/collect winnings, players must have a Gardens Casino player's card in addition to a valid U.S. government issued ID or passport for non U.S. residents. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. treaty will be subject to withholding. All out of state residents are subject to tax withholdings.
