All levels will be 30 minutes until tournament is concluded. Ante is paid before the big blind. Registration will close at the start of the 9th level (Approx. 9:20pm). Top 12.5% of entries will make the money. Players may re-enter. Day 1 will play until the end of level 14. Day 2 will start on Sunday 1/12 at 1pm. This event will be 8-handed; redraw for seats at the end of Day 1 and at 9 on Day 2. Tournament ends at last player with chips or if players agree to divide the remaining prize pool at the final table. *\$4,700 buy-in + \$200 entry fee + \$100 service charge. Entry fee and service charge not added to prize pool. 100% of buy-in goes toward the prize pool. The Action Clock by Protection Poker will be used starting on Day 2 when manageable. Players will have 30 seconds to act on their hand. Players will receive 5 time extensions worth 30 seconds each. Players' time extensions will carry over to the final table where each player will receive 5 additional time extension buttons. In the case that time expires for a player with remaining time extension chips, the player's Action Clock will automatically extend an additional 30 seconds. Collection of time extension buttons will take place at the end of the player's action. If a player's Action Clock expires and the player does not have any time extension chips remaining, he or she will be (a) forced to check if there is no bet pending or (b) fold if facing a bet or raise. In order to register/collect winnings, players must have a Gardens Casino player's card in addition to a valid U.S. government issued ID or passport for non U.S. residents. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. treaty will be subject to withholding. All out of state residents are subject to tax withholdings.
